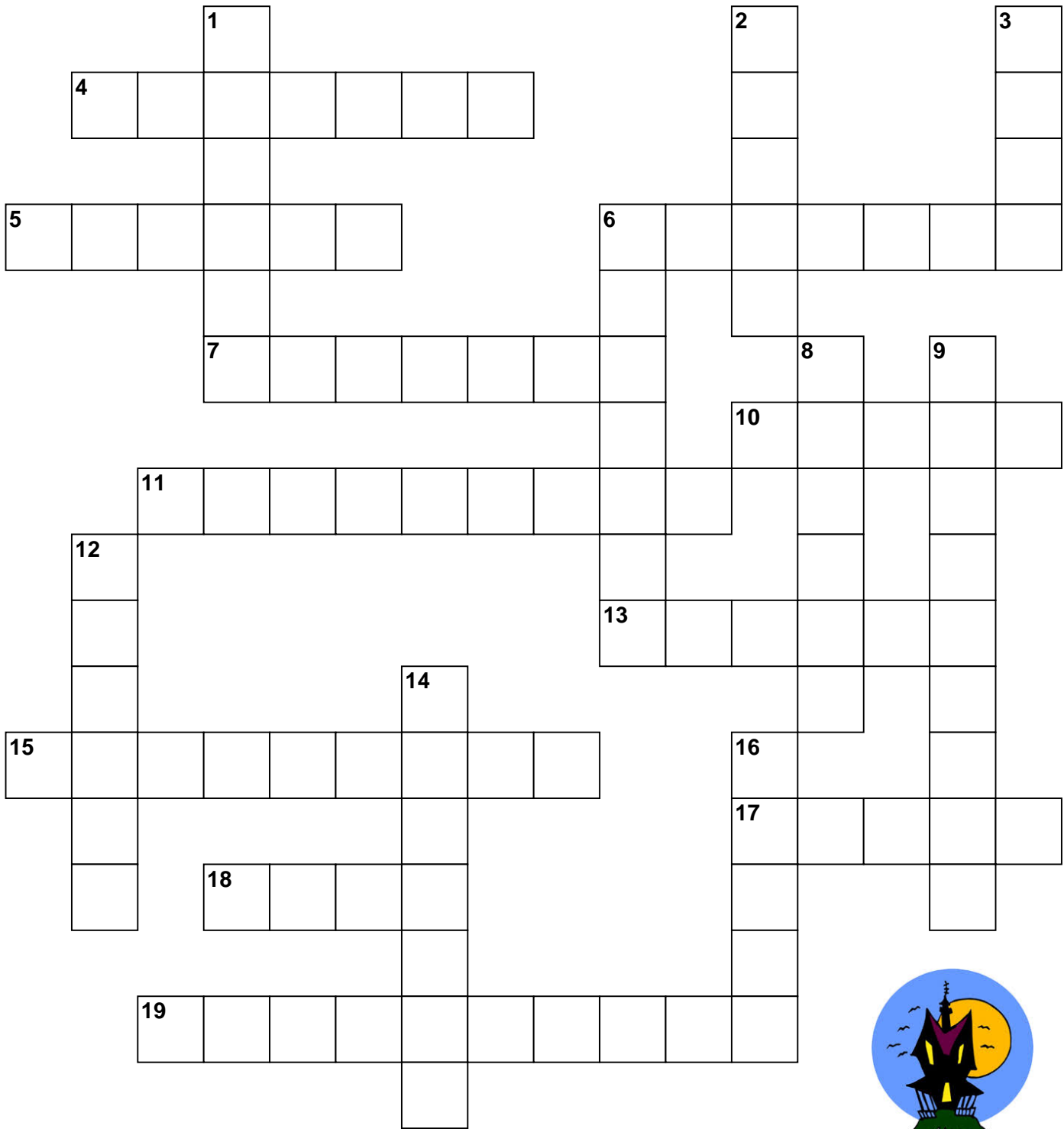

ACROSS

- 4 Walk on sidewalks facing this when possible
- 5 Condition of being free from danger
- 6 Clothing worn to look like some other person, animal or thing
- 7 Should not be carved by a small child
- 10 Small meal eaten between meals
- 11 Plant that can be used for food
- 13 Look both ways before crossing
- 15 October 31 celebration when children wear costumes and beg for treats
- 17 Plan and agree on safe one with older children
- 18 Harvest season with chilly temperatures
- 19 Hold to help others see you better

DOWN

- 1 Should be worn instead of masks for better vision
- 2 Never enter for a treat
- 3 Fasten the reflective kind on costumes and bags for better visibility
- 6 Never walk near these when wearing a costume
- 8 Costume accessories that should be short, soft, and flexible
- 9 Decorative, non-prescription types should not be worn
- 12 Examine all for choking hazards and tampering before eating
- 14 Being free from sickness
- 16 Healthy treat that can be eaten raw
